## Materials

$11 / 4$ yards Typewriter Keys - Black (B) 9707-99
$1 / 2$ yard Urban Legend - Chocolate (C)
2/3 yard Maps Background - Fawn (D)
7101-37

1 yard Gears - Chocolate (E)
1 panel Blocks - Tan (F)
$21 / 4$ yards Urban Legend - Black (G)
$1 / 3$ yard Urban Legend - Gray (H)
$1 / 4$ yard Top Hats - Tan (I)
1/4 yard Corsets - Ivory (J)
$21 / 3$ yards Hot Air Balloons - Tan (K)
$51 / 2$ yards Patch - Tan (Backing)
*Includes binding

From the Blocks - Tan (F):

- Fussy cut (12) 7 "x 9" strips each centered on a block.

From the Urban Legend - Black (G), cut:

- (1) $33 / 4$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $33 / 4$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) $33 / 4$ " triangles.
- (2) $33 / 8 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $33 / 8 "$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (32) $33 / 8$ " triangles.
- (3) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $3 "$ squares.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 76 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 571 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $2 " \times 9 "$ strips.
- (6) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $2 " \times 10 "$ strips.

From the Urban Legend - Gray (H), cut:

- (2) $33 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $33 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) $33 / 4$ " triangles.


## From the Panel - Chestnut (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $23 "$ x $43 "$ panel.

From the Typewriter Keys - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " $x 43$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 26$ " WOF strips from the remaining fabric.
- (22) $31 / 4 "$ squares from the remaining fabric. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (88) $31 / 4 "$ triangles. Note: Not all triangles will be used.


## From the Urban Legend - Chocolate (C), cut:

- (1) $33 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $33 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) $33 / 4$ " triangles.
- (2) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $33 / 8 "$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (32) $33 / 8$ " triangles.
- Cut (34) Template \#1 blocks.


## From the Maps Background - Fawn (D), cut:

- (1) $51 / 4 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) $51 / 4 "$ triangles. Note: Only (30) triangles will be used.
- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and (4) $21 / 2 "$ squares. Cut the $27 / 8 "$ squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangles.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 301 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Gears - Chocolate (E), cut:

-(3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.

- (5) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $21 / 2 "$ x $101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Top Hats - Tan (I), cut:
-(1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Corsets - Ivory (J), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Hot Air Balloons - Tan (K), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 "$ x $791 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.


## From the Patch - Tan (Backing), cut:

-(2) $97 " x$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $75 " \times 97 "$ back.

## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" $x 43 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $23 " \times 43 "$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x $26 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

## Quilt 1

Note: The arrows in Figures 2-5 denote fabric print direction. Also, pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the units.
2. Sew (1) $31 / 4 "$ Fabric B triangle to adjacent sides of (1) Fabric C-Template 1 block to make (1) Unit 1 triangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (11) Unit 1 triangles.
3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-5 for fabric identification, placement and fabric orientation to make (11) Unit 2 triangles, (6) Unit 3 triangles and (6) Unit 4 triangles.

4. Sew together (11) Unit 1 triangles and (10) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric D triangles alternating them. Sew (1) $2^{7 / 8}$ " Fabric D triangle to each end of the sewn strip to make the Pieced Left Side Border (Fig. 6).
5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 7 below for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Pieced Right Side Border.
6. Sew (6) Unit 1 triangles and (5) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric D triangles together alternating them. Sew (1) $27 / 8 "$ Fabric D triangle to each end of the sewn strip. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square to each end of the new strip to make the Pieced Top Border (Fig. 8).

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 9 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Pieced Bottom Border.

8. Sew (1) $2 " \times 9 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of (1) 7 " $\times 9 "$ Fabric F strip. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F strip to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 10). Trim the block to measure $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make (12) Block One rectangles total.

9. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Block One rectangle to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (6) Block Two rectangles total.

10. Sew (1) $33 / 4 "$ Fabric H triangle and (1) $33 / 4 "$ Fabric G triangle together. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew (1) $33 / 8$ " Fabric C triangle to the long side of the sewn triangle to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 12). Trim the unit to measure 3 " square. Repeat to make (32) Unit 5 squares total.
11. Sew (1) $33 / 4 "$ Fabric C triangle and (1) $33 / 4 "$ Fabric H triangle together. Pay attention to the triangle orientations. Sew (1) $33 / 8 "$ Fabric G triangle to the long side of the sewn triangle to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 13). Trim the unit to measure 3 " square. Repeat to make (32) Unit 6 squares total.
12. Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (32) Unit 7 strips total.

13. Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew (1) Unit 7 strip to each side of (1) $5^{1 / 2 \prime}$ Fabric I square lengthwise. Sew (1) 3" Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 7 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Block Three squares total.

14. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Block Three square to make (1) Block Four rectangle (Fig. 16). Repeat to make a second Block Four rectangle.

15. Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew (1) Unit 7 strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric J square lengthwise. Sew (1) 3 " Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 7 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric J square to make (1) Block Four square (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (4) Block Five squares total.

16. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Block Five square to make (1) Block Six rectangle (Fig. 18). Repeat to make a second Block Six rectangle.

## Quilt Top Assembly

## (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

17. Sew the Pieced Left Side Border and the Pieced Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block. Sew the Pieced Top Border and Pieced Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 481 / 2^{"}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
19. Sew (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle and (1) Block Two rectangle together. Sew the new strip to the left side of the Center Block.
20. Sew (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block Six rectangle and (1) Block Two rectangle together. Sew the new strip to the right side of the Center Block.
21. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
22. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block Five square and (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip together. Sew the new strip to the top of the Center Block.
23. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block Five square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 / 1 \times 10 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 / 2 \times 10 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block Three square and (1) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip together. Sew the new strip to the bottom of the Center Block.
24. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
25. Sew (1) $2 " \times 761 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $571 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
26. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 791 / 2 "$ Fabric $K$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 671 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
27. Layer and quilt as desired.
28. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
29. Bind as desired.
